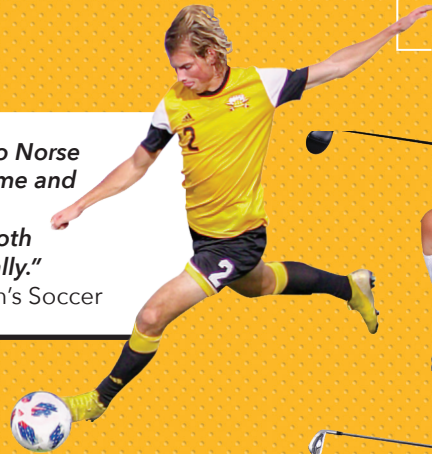

BASEBALL Andrew Bacon is a two-time Horizon League All-Academic Team honoree who holds a 3.88 GPA in Business Information Systems.

WOMEN'S TENNIS The women's tennis team recorded the highest team GPA in Fall 2019 with a 3.87.



MEN'S GOLF The men's golf team claimed first place at the ECU Intercollegiate, with Joe Clark & Avery Green claiming co-medalist honors. This was the team's first win as a DI program.

WOMEN'S SOCCER After recording a 3.68 cumulative GPA during the 2018-19 academic year, the women's soccer team was awarded the United Soccer Coaches College Team Academic Award for the 14th-straight year.

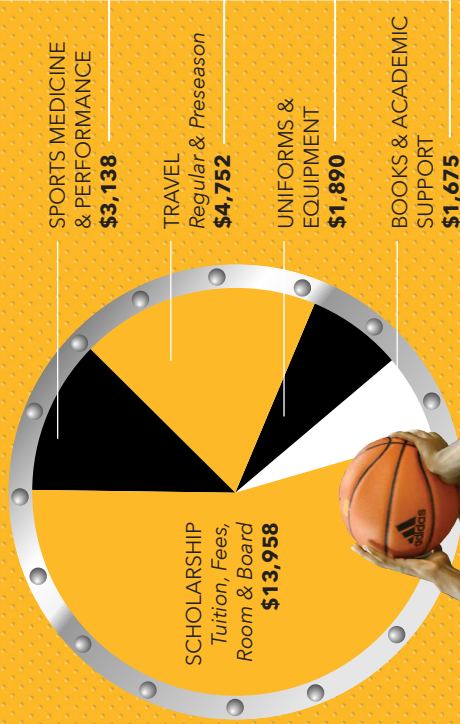


THE GO NORSE FUND

ACADEMIC SUCCESS 3.39 GPA

NKU student-athletes achieved a **3.39 GPA** in Fall 2019, making this the 17th-straight semester of a department **GPA of 3.0 or higher**, and 11th-straight semester **GPA of 3.2 or higher**.

154 student-athletes earned a **3.0 GPA** or higher, with **27** of them earning a **4.0 GPA** in Fall 2019.

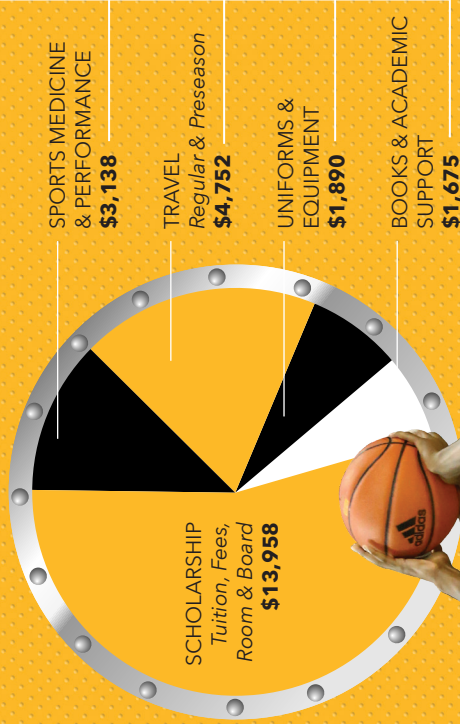
